- Goat weigh-in will be from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 a.m. on Saturday, August 17. Lambs will weigh-in from 10:00 a.m. until 11:00 a.m.
- The show will start at 9:00 a.m. with goats. The lamb show will start immediately following the conclusion of the goat show.
- The show will be held at the Billy Walker Animal Science Facility on the campus of Coffee Middle School. The address is 901 Ga. Hwy 206 N., Douglas, Georgia. This is an air-conditioned facility.
- We will be using a jackpot format to pay out prize money. Exhibitors will receive their prize money at the show.
- Bring your own bedding. Pens and 5x5 and are First Come First Serve. Showing from your trailer is allowed.
- The Lamb show will be a Ga. Club Lamb Association point show.

BRING ON THE HEAT MARKET GOAT AND LAMB SHOW

Air-Conditioned Arena

Billy Walker Animal Science Facility on the campus of Coffee Middle School 901 Ga. Hwy 206 N., Douglas, Georgia 31533

- 1.) Eligibility: The show will be open to all states. Classes are open only to 4-H and FFA Members through the 12th grade (plus pre-club age children in grades K-4 and at least 5 yrs. of age by Sept. 1).
- 2.) Entries must be wethers or ewes for lambs and does or wethers for goats. NO RAMS or BUCKS.
- 3.) Entries must be show ready. Sheep must be slick shorn and goats must be clipped.
- 4.) Class Weight: Animals will be weighed and divided into classes.
- 5.) Number of Entries: Each exhibitor may enter a maximum of five animals of each species.
- 6.) ENTRY DEADLINE: August 9, 2019. Late entries will be accepted until August 14, 2019.
- 7.) All goats must be dehorned or have horns tipped.
- 8.) All animals must be tagged with some kind of identification number. No tattoos will be accepted. A State tag is recommended.
- 9.) No substitute animals. Bring only the ones you entered.
 - 1. Exhibitor must show his/her own lamb/goat in showmanship.
 - 2. Exhibitor must show his/her own lamb/goat in weight class. Substitute showman must be approved by show committee.
- 10.) EXCESSIVE force or abuse will not be TOLERATED!
- 11.) NO PERSON OTHER THAN EXHIBITORS, THE JUDGE, SHOW COMMITTEE OR ITS REPRESENTATIVES WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE SHOW RING.
- 12.) HEALTH PAPERS: Certificate of Veterinary Inspection with the following statement must be shown.

 "No evidence of foot rot, scabies, sore mouth, or cutaneous fungal disease". All animals should be listed separately on Certificate. All animals must have a Scrapie Tag.
- 13.) Decisions made by the show committee are final.
- 14.) Showing from trailer is allowed.
- 15.) BRACING WILL BE ALLOWED.
- 16.) The Bring on the Heat Market Goat and Lamb Show Committee reserves the right to review the rules and make changes if necessary.
- 17.) Any official complaint must be in writing and accompanied by \$50.00 non-refundable cash deposit.
- 18.) Lambs will be classified as Black Faced, Natural, White Faced/Speckled, and Hair sheep, if numbers permit.
- 19.) Payouts will be determined by number of entries.

We ask that you please be respectful of every exhibitor and NOT bring any animals that have active contagious fungal disease. Thank you for your cooperation and attention in this matter.

BRING YOUR OWN BEDDING. PENS ARE FIRST COME FIRST SERVE.

The Bring on the Heat Show Committee will pay at least 3 places in Class and 3 places in Showmanship. Additional money will be paid to Grand and Reserve.
