SHOW RULES

- All Georgia 4-H and FFA State Livestock Show Rules and Regulations will be followed.
- The Show Committee has final decision making privileges over all show rules.
- Unless permission by the show committee is given, exhibitors must show his/her animals in all classes. The show is open to any current 4-H or FFA member.
- Animals must have state issued 4-H or FFA ear tag to show in the show. A scrapie tag will suffice for states without state tags. Entries that do not have correct tag will be disqualified and no refunds will be given.
- An official Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (Health Certificate) with the individual animal identification number is required to show. An inspector with the State Department of Agriculture may be on site and current health papers must be available upon request.
- All lambs and goats are shown as market livestock, there will be no breeding show. Weight will determine market classes; there is no weight requirement. There will be no re-weighing once the animal has left the scale area.
- For goats, wethers and does will be shown separately. All lambs will show together.

- There will be a “Georgia Born and Bred” division for each show (market lamb, market wether, market doe). The highest placing GA Born and Bred animal from each weight class will return to the ring for the Georgia Born and Bred division immediately prior to the Grand Drive of the respective show. “Georgia Born and Bred” must be marked on the entry form for an animal to be eligible.
- As space is limited, please pen with your county. Pen space is limited and available on a first-come, first-served basis, **thus exhibitors are encouraged to show off the trailer.**
- The owner is responsible for the care and cleanup of his/her own animal(s).
- Shavings for bedding purposes are in the barn.
- For showmanship, exhibitors will be classified based on grade level as of September 1, 2021.

ENTRY AND PREMIUMS

- Entry fee is \$25.00 per lamb and/or goat.
- **Completed entry form with payment** must be postmarked no later than Monday, August 16, 2021. Any entry postmarked/received after August 16th will be charged a \$10 late fee per animal; no exceptions.
- Entry fees are non-refundable; no exceptions.
- For lambs, entries must be wether or ewe; no rams will be allowed. For goats, entries must be wether or doe; no bucks will be allowed.
