- 1. Show will be held at the state of the art, air conditioned Gilmer County Agriculture Education Center located at 1020 Clear Creek Road in Ellijay, Georgia 30536.
- 2. SHOW WILL BE LIMITED TO 220 ANIMALS INCLUDING BOTH SPECIES. FIRST COME, FIRST SERVE.
- 3. The Show is open to 4-H and FFA members.
- 4. All Georgia 4-H and FFA State Livestock Rules and Regulations will be followed.
- 5. Only Wethers and Does Allowed. **NO BUCKS**. All animals will be shown as market.
- 6. **Weigh In:** After the animals leave the scales there will be no additional weigh in without show official consent. Weigh in begins Saturday, **SEPTEMBER 10**, 2022 from 7 a.m. to 8:30 a.m.
- 7. Animals will be weighed and divided into classes as equal in number as possible. (Number of classes may vary depending on the number of entries and the show official's discretion).
- 8. Exhibitors may register and show up to 6 animals of both species.
- Classes: Exhibitors must show their own animal in class. If the exhibitor has more than one animal in a
 class, they can have another exhibitor show for them. This must be cleared with show officials before
 showing.
- 10. The goat show will be split into a doe show and wether show. Lambs will be shown together.
- 11. All animals must be dehorned or have horns tipped.
- 12. THERE WILL BE NO PAINTING OF LAMBS.
- 13. Animals must be carrying all milk teeth at time of weigh-in. Animals showing either or both of the first pair of permanent incisors will not be eligible to show.
- 14. All animals must be ear tagged with state identification tags.
- 15. **Showmanship**: Each exhibitor must show their own animal in showmanship. The animal must be entered in the show and owned by the exhibitor.
- 16. Goat Showmanship will start at 9:30 AM. Market Goat classes will follow showmanship and Lamb Showmanship will start after the Market Goat weight classes. Lamb weight classes will start after Lamb Showmanship.
- 17. Due to the limited space, pens will be assigned on a first come first served basis with approximately 120 pens available. (The show committee reserves the right to ask you to house your animal on your trailer if we run out of pen space.) Pen Alterations are not allowed. There will be at least 2 animals per pen. BRING YOUR OWN SHAVINGS!
- 18. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspections is required with the individual identification and the following statement: FLOCK OF ORIGIN IS FREE FROM FOOT ROT, SCABIES, CONTAGIOUS ECTHYMA (SOREMOUTH), CUTANEOUS FUNGAL LESIONS, SCRAPIE, And/or ANY OTHER INFECTIOUS DISEASE. Any visible sick animal will be asked to leave the premises.
- 19. All goats must have a USDA approved scrapie tag in the ear. Registration numbers will not serve as the scrapie tag for the show.
- 20. **Entry Fee**: The entry fee per animal is \$25. Late entries fee will be charged an additional \$20.00 per exhibitor. Money will be used for prize money after expenses are removed. Amount of prize money is based on entries and is subject to change*:

Payouts will be for the following:

Top 5 Individuals in Classes (market classes and showmanship)

Top 5 Does and Top 5 Wethers

Top 5 Lambs (If numbers justify and lambs will not be classified)

- 21. The Gilmer County FFA reserves the right to review the rules and make changes if necessary. All decisions made by the Gilmer County FFA are final.
- 22. No alcoholic beverages or weapons on school premises are allowed; any violators will be asked to leave immediately.
- 23. Show officials have the right to reduce price payout based on entries received without notice.
