


Southern Premier Lamb & Goat Show

2021 Rules & Regulations



- 1) Eligibility: Our show will be open to all states and all students enrolled in 4-H or FFA. Exhibitors must not have graduated.
- 2) All entries must be born after **January 1, 2021**. Lambs and Goats must be wethers or ewes/does. NO BUCKS.
- 3) Goat show will be broken down into 2 divisions, wethers and does, lamb show will be broken down into 6 divisions Black Faced Light Weight, Mid Weight, Havey Weight, White Faced, and Natural.
- 4) Showmanship classes will be broken down by grade levels and weight class will be divided into equal classes based on entries.
- 5) There will be **NO LIMIT** to number of animals an exhibitor can show, the more the better.
- 6) All animals must have a scrapie identification tag and must be used on entry forms.
- 7) Entry deadline will be **July 16, 2021**. All entries must be received or postmarked by this date. All entries after this date will be \$40.00/Head. Day of show \$50.00/Head.
- 8) No persons other than Judge, show ring help and exhibitors will be allowed in the ring.
- 9) Health papers/certificate of veterinary inspection must be present day of show and turned in at weigh-in. All animals must show no signs of foot rot, sore mouth, or fungus. Scrapie tag numbers must be listed for all animals being entered into the show.
- 10) Showing from trailer will be allowed, you must supply own power source unless using one of the 9 building trailer spots. Please indicate on entry form if you will be showing off your trailer for building or generator spot. If not wanting to show off trailer pens will be available for \$10(bedding will be supplied) and they will be assigned to each exhibitor. We will do our best to keep counties together, understanding that some will be sharing equipment.
- 11) Barn will open on Friday @12:00pm for the goat show and will be reopen Saturday at 6:00am for the lamb show. If you are only showing in the lamb show, please wait until Saturday morning to bring lambs into the barn and parking in trailer spot. We are trying to make it less compact in the barn and in the trailer spots.
- 12) Any official complaint must be in writing and a fee of \$50.00 must be turned in. If complaint is deemed needed and addressed the \$50.00 will be refunded to applicant.
- 13) Payouts will be as followed for both Lamb and Goat show:

Showmanship Top 3	1 st \$30.00&Prize, 2 nd \$25.00, 3 rd \$20.00
Weight Classes Top 5	1 st \$50.00&Prize, 2 nd \$45.00, 3 rd \$40.00, 4 th \$35.00, 5 th \$30.00
